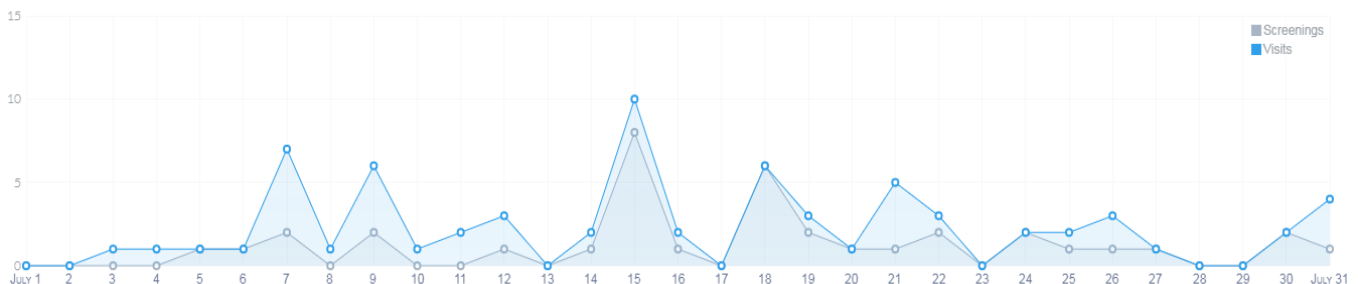

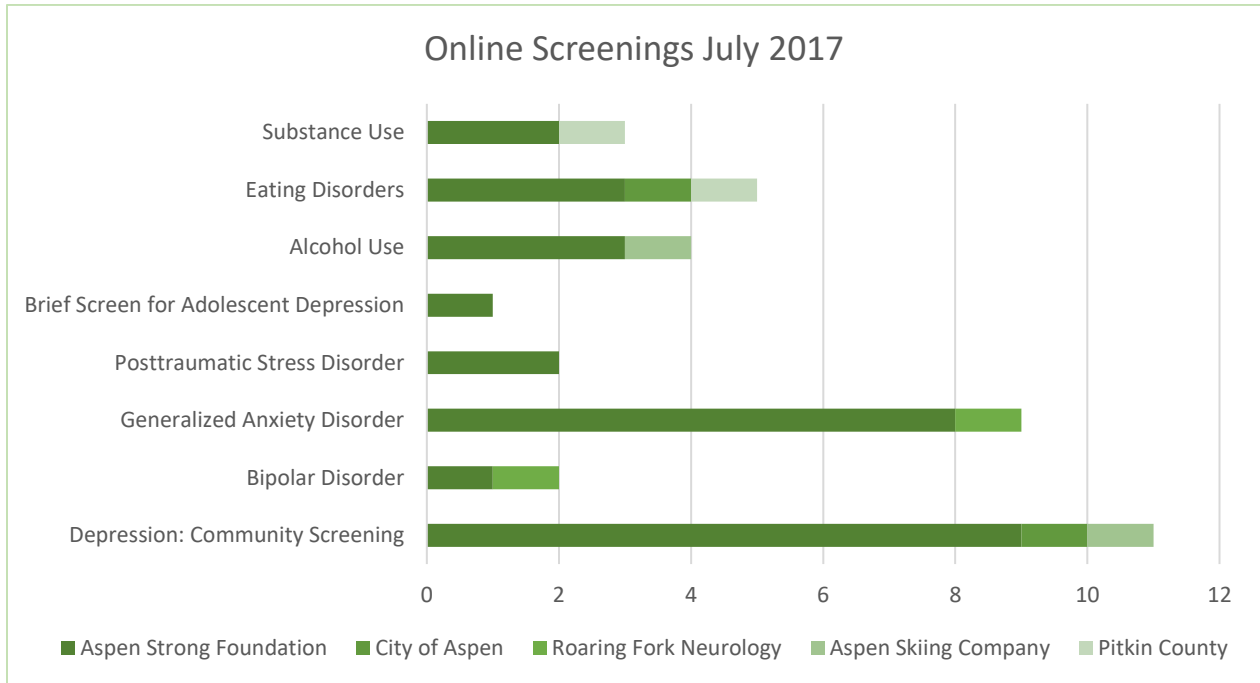

Screenings by Day



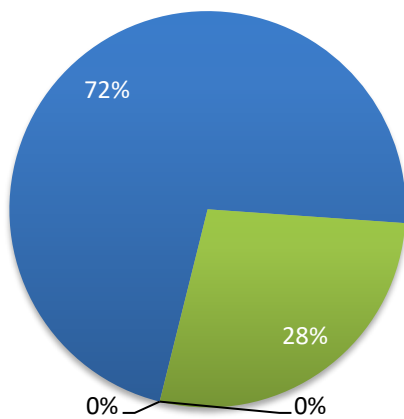
Partner Site Screening Breakdown

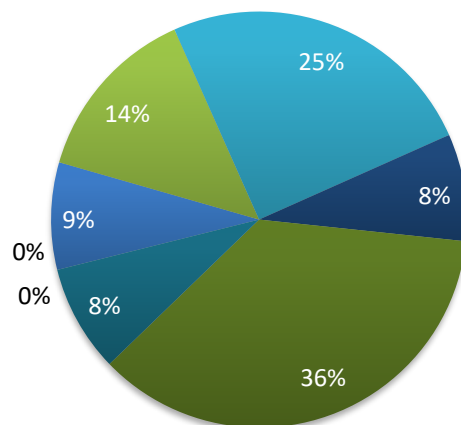

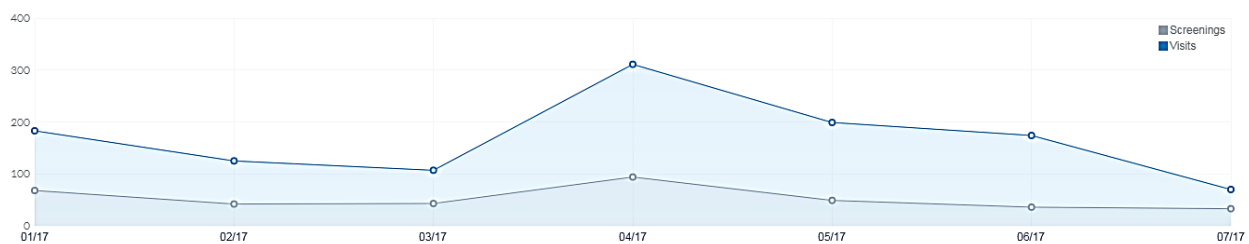
July 15th Aspen Brain Lab & Aspen Valley Marathon

- 8 online screenings took place the day of the event (22% of screenings for the month)

Promotional Language

During the month of July 2017, **37 online mental health screenings were taken**. This number is lower than that from past months, with 68 screenings in January, 42 in February, 43 in March, 94 in April, and 49 in May. The screening count for July is similar to June (36 in June), which can likely be accounted for by the fact that many people go away on vacation during the summer months. Screening numbers are anticipated to rise as we approach National Suicide Prevention Month in September and National Depression Screening Day at the beginning of October.

2017 Screenings by Month



Aspen Strong's major event in July, the Aspen Brain Lab and Aspen Valley Marathon, took place on July 15th and marked a peak in screening numbers for the month with **8 online mental health screenings taken**.

*Of the **23** people who scored positive for a mental health disorder, only **5** answered the optional question "Do you plan to seek help?" Of those 5 who responded, **1** reported that they did indeed intend to seek help.*
